Membership of Croydon Chess Club

Croydon Chess Club is not-for-profit association run by its members. It has an Annual General Meeting each year which elects a Committee to manage the club and its finances.

Membership Fee

This is an annual fee which entitles membership from the date membership is approved to 31st December. The membership fee for the next year then becomes due.

If you join part way through the year, the fee is quarterly pro-rata plus a small administration fee.

Membership approval

Generally club membership is approved by the Secretary on behalf of the Club Committee. Continuing membership may be subject to review by the Club Committee.

Levels of Membership

Member – 15 or over. Entitled to vote at General Meetings, but must be over 18 to be nominated for a position on the Committee.

Associate member – under 15. Not entitled to vote at General Meetings.

General:

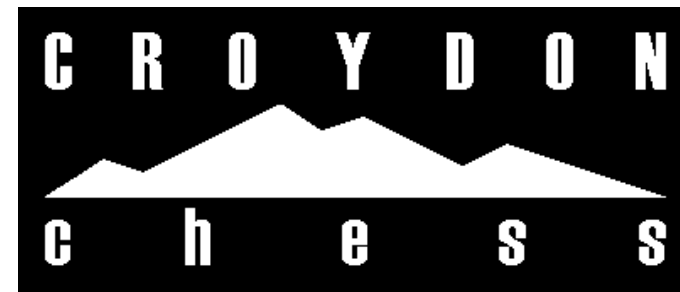
1. Free attendance for members and their immediate families at all club activities and functions.
