Membership of Croydon Chess Club

Croydon Chess Club is not-for-profit association run by its members. It has an Annual General Meeting each year which elects a Committee to manage the club and its finances.

Membership Fee

This is an annual fee which entitles membership from the date membership is approved to 31st December. The membership fee for the next year then becomes due.

If you join part way through the year, the fee is quarterly pro-rata plus a small administration fee.

Membership approval

Generally, club membership is approved by the Secretary on behalf of the Club Committee. Continuing membership may be subject to review by the Club Committee.

Levels of Membership

Member – 15 or over. Entitled to vote at General Meetings, but must be over 18 to be nominated for a position on the Committee.

Associate member – under 15. Not entitled to vote at General Meetings. Parents are welcome to attend the AGM.

Benefits of Membership

General:

1. Free attendance for members and their immediate families at all club activities and functions.
2. Discounted entry fee to all senior club tournaments.
3. Able to borrow the club's chess books and DVDs.

Junior members, in addition to the above, receive:

1. Free coaching.
2. Free entry to all junior club and youth club tournaments.

Responsibilities of Membership

1. At all club activities and functions, members and their families are expected to behave respectfully towards others.
2. In club tournaments, follow the established chess etiquette and the Laws of Chess. In particular, refrain from cheating or arranging the results of games.
3. Facilitate and assist in the proper functioning of the club.
4. Follow the reasonable directions of club officials.
5. Look after and treat with care club facilities and equipment.
